



## WEE COUNTY HARRIERS – SOCIAL MEDIA POLICY

The following policy relates to social media use by club members on the club's private Facebook group, private Strava group and the club's public social media channels.

- Members shall interact on all club forums in a respectful manner and accept that there are a wide range of views on different subjects across the membership
- Members shall not share any content on club forums which is discriminatory in nature
- Members shall respect that posts in the club's private Facebook group should not be shared outwith the group or with people who are not members of the club, unless it is for the purposes of promoting the club via the club's official Facebook page. In the event that any member asks for content to be removed, this shall be respected
- Members responsible for content on the club's public-facing social media channels shall ensure that content is appropriate and presents the club and its members in a positive light
- Members shall refrain from using social media channels to complain about other members, this should be done using the club's complaints procedures, if appropriate
- Senior members shall not send friend requests to junior members
- Only paid or honorary members of the club shall have access to the private Facebook group and members should not invite others to join the page unless they are paid members
- Admins reserve the right to delete any posts or comments which could cause offence
